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## **National Women's Health Resource Center: 2008 Annual Women's Health Survey**

### **Topline Results**

Field Dates: September 25, 2008 – October 2, 2008  
Sample size: 754 adult women age 18+

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#### **Methodology**

This survey was conducted online within the United States by Harris Interactive on behalf of the National Women's Health Resource Center between September 25 and October 2, 2008 among 754 women aged 18 or older.

All sample surveys and polls, whether or not they use probability sampling, are subject to multiple sources of error which are most often not possible to quantify or estimate, including sampling error, coverage error, error associated with nonresponse, error associated with question wording and response options, and post-survey weighting and adjustments. Therefore, Harris Interactive avoids the words "margin of error" as they are misleading. All that can be calculated are different possible sampling errors with different probabilities for pure, unweighted, random samples with 100% response rates. These are only theoretical because no published polls come close to this ideal.

Respondents for this survey were selected from among those who have agreed to participate in Harris Interactive surveys. The data have been weighted to reflect the composition of the adult women in the United States. Because the sample is based on those who agreed to be invited to participate in the Harris Interactive online research panel, no estimates of theoretical sampling error can be calculated.
